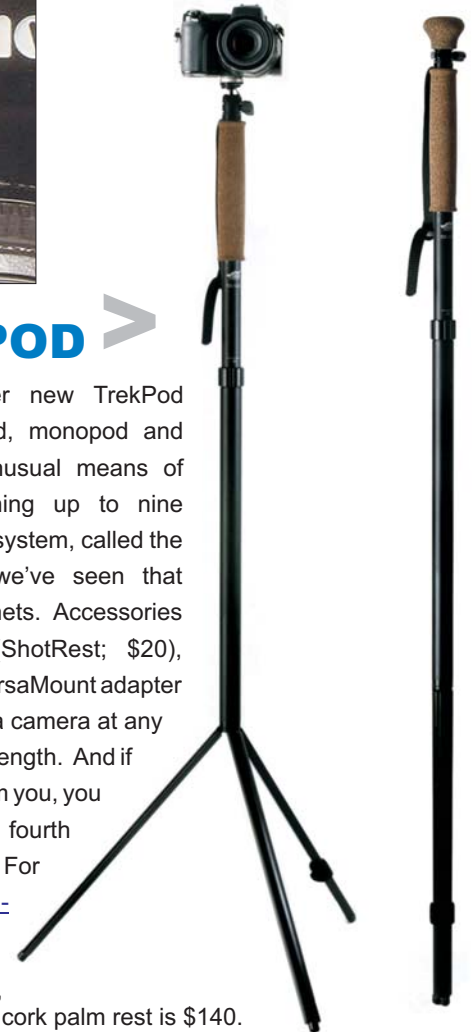

### 3-IN-1 TRIPOD >

Trek Technologies' clever new TrekPod (\$105\*, direct) is a tripod, monopod and walking stick, with an unusual means of attaching cameras weighing up to nine pounds. Its quick-release system, called the MagMount, is the first we've seen that uses—you guessed it—magnets. Accessories include a lens cradle (ShotRest; \$20), carrying case (\$40), and VersaMount adapter (\$20), that lets you attach a camera at any point along the monopod's length. And if someone tries to steal it from you, you can use the TrekPod in its fourth incarnation: as a club. For details, see [www.trek-tech.com](http://www.trek-tech.com).
